Dear Journey Parents and Students,

We are so excited for our upcoming week at Hume SoCal Summer Camp! All the information you need to get ready for camp can be found in the letter and packet that follows. As always I want to encourage you to be praying for our time together up on the mountain both while there and in preparation. Remember camp is **July 18th-July 23rd**. **We will be leaving for camp on Monday July, 18th from the church parking lot at 1:00 pm (please arrive at 12:30)**. We are located on the corner of Alton and Creek. We will **return to our church on Saturday July 23rd around 11:00am**. This packet contains everything you'll need to make camp a positive experience. Please look over the material and **send us back your completed forms. All forms MUST be turned into our office on or before July 18th.**

This packet contains:

1. Journey Medical Release Forms
2. Camp Packing List

Other things you need to know:

1. The total cost is \$625 (includes transportation, camp fees, food, and lodging at camp.)
2. The final payment is due on or before **July 18th**. You can make the final payment by check or cash, or by going to www.journeyoc.com, selecting the give tab, and choosing the fund "Hume So Cal Camp Sr. High"
3. Suggested spending money for the trip is \$50. (This is for snacks, clothing or anything else a student may desire while at camp but is not necessary)
4. At camp, the camp nurse will keep all medication. Please make sure your name is on all items, and they are placed in a zip-lock bag with your child's name clearly printed on the outside. (Emergency inhalers can be held on to by campers)
5. While at camp each student is expected to conduct him or herself in an appropriate manner. There are two things that can get a student sent home from camp. The first, disrespect to any leader, camp staff, or other student. The second, if the student brings any illegal substances, alcohol, tobacco, firearms, etc...
6. Cell Phones are not allowed to be used while at camp.
7. The spirit day theme is 70's Attire! So if you would like to dress up bring your best 70's themed attire.

CONSENT AND LIABILITY RELEASE FORM

It is my desire that my child/ward participate in the activities of Journey Christian Church, therefore:

I, the undersigned parent/guardian of _____, do hereby authorize an adult sponsor of Journey Christian Church or any responsible adult person bearing this written authorization, into who's said care the above mentioned minor child has been entrusted, to obtain proper medical care from a licensed medical or dental doctor or facility. The medical/dental care is to include, but not be limited to, any x-ray, examination, anesthetic, medical or surgical diagnosis or treatment and hospital care to be rendered to said minor under the general or special supervision and upon the advice of a licensed medical doctor or dentist.

It is understood that this authorization is given in advance of any specific diagnosis, treatment or hospital care being required, but is given to provide authority and power on the part of said adult person to give specific consent to any and all such diagnosis, treatment or hospital care which the aforementioned physician or dentist in the exercise of his best judgment may deem advisable. This authorization shall include transportation to receive the medical or dental care.

FINANCIAL RESPONSIBILITY

In the event of injury to my child/ward, I agree that I/we and my healthcare insurer shall be financially responsible for any medical treatment required by my child/ward as a result of any injury or illness suffered during his/her participation in any church related activities.

RISK

I am aware that the activities my child is engaging in (as well as any necessary medical treatment provided as a result of said activity) may involve hazards and risks of significant injury or death as one of the results associated with the activity. I have considered these risks and I still wish my child/ward to participate in said activities despite the gravity of said risks. Furthermore, I agree not to bring any legal action against Journey Christian Church, staff, sponsors or person making the medical decisions as a result of any injury sustained while engaging in the church sponsored event (or any subsequent medical treatment provided thereafter) or injuries/death suffered in the course of his/her participation.

DISPUTE

Any disputes arising between myself and Journey Christian Church or its agents/chaperones concerning injuries to my child/ward shall be resolved by arbitration with Judicate West. This waiver is hereby acknowledged as a valid defense, and should the arbitrator/judge find, a complete defense to any claims/lawsuits. The cost of the arbitrator is to be shared equally by the parties.

TERM OF AGREEMENT

This authorization will remain in effect from May 1, 2022 until May 1, 2023, while the minor above is enroute to or from or involved or participating in any program or activity authorized by Journey Christian Church, unless revoked by the undersigned in writing and delivered to the agent of Journey Christian Church.

What to Bring:

- Pen or Pencil
- Note Pad

- Camera (optional)
- Spending money for activities and snacks (\$10-\$15/day recommended for Ponderosa, Meadow Ranch and Hume SD; \$5/day recommended for Wagon Train and Wildwood)

What Not to Bring:

- Electronics: cell phones (there is no cell reception at Hume Lake), iPods, CD players, radios, TVs or computer games; Alcohol, drugs, fireworks, knives, guns, etc.
